

Mathematics



Number and place value - we will be counting on and back in ones, tens, hundreds and thousands from any given number. We will read, write and partition 4 digit numbers. (3 digit numbers - Year 3)

We will compare and order amounts and then solve number problems.

Written addition and subtraction - add 2 or more three and four-digit numbers using a formal written method (two and three-digit numbers - Year 3)

We will be using a formal method to subtract three and four-digit numbers with exchanges (two and three-digit numbers with one exchange- Year 3)

Add and subtract multiples of 10 and 100 from three-digit numbers (Year 3). Add and subtract multiples of 10, 100 and 1000 from four-digit numbers (Year 4).

Science

Food and Digestive System

As scientists, we will learn about the human digestive system. We will explore the main parts, starting with the mouth and teeth, identifying teeth types and their functions.

Religious Education

Studying who or what is God and how is the Divine understood across religions.

Reading:

We will be reading texts such as *George's Marvellous Medicine* and *Charlotte's Web* with a focus on reading with expression, comprehension and identifying the effects of different words and phrases to create different images and atmosphere. The book *Anglo-Saxon boy* will link in with our Invasion topic.



Writing:

As writers we will be writing setting descriptions using skills learnt from our reading and getting inspiration from texts such as *The Tin Forest* and *The Flower*. For our non-fiction focus, we will write explanation texts which will link with our science theme, digestion.

Oracy

We will use specialist vocabulary when discussing a known topic. We will consider the impact of our words on others when giving feedback.

History and Geography

As Historians we will be learning about life in Britain after the Roman withdrawal. Including the Anglo-Saxon and Viking invasions up to the Norman conquest.

We will study the chronology of the invasions and then look in depth at the Anglo-Saxon and Viking kingdoms including their beliefs, customs, religion and everyday life. We will then move on to the Norman invasion and the legacy.

Art and DT

As artists we will be experimenting with drawing techniques and colour mixing to produce artwork which shows natural details and shapes. We will be looking at artwork by Yellena James for inspiration.
